- 4. What do you think Katherine is thinking and feeling during the scene with the Tailor and Haberdasher? (Page 169-177)
- 5. Read this scientific description of the shrew: "Shrews are very active, solitary, surface-dwellers. They are very voracious and suffer from lack of food within a few hours...Shrews are preyed upon extensively by birds, but much less so by mammalian carnivores...Dispersion is maintained by aggressive behavior at all times, except during the brief period of oestrus and copulation. The fighting is stereotyped and involves great use of the voice, resulting in 'squeaking matches'." (Corbert, *The Terrestrial Mammals of Western Europe*)
